

JUST IN FUN IS ON THE MOVE.....AGAIN!

After careful consideration, the Just In Fun Committee has decided to gradually resume travel in **as safe an** environment as is humanly possible. We have been reviewing the guidelines issued by the CDC, which recommends that fully vaccinated people can travel at low risk to themselves when taking precautions while traveling (wearing masks, avoiding crowds, socially distancing, and washing and sanitizing hands frequently). The CDC has not changed the agency's existing guidance for unvaccinated people and discourages non-essential domestic travel by those not fully vaccinated. You are considered fully vaccinated two weeks after receiving the last recommended dose of vaccine.

Just **In** Fun has formalized the following guidelines for our travelers to follow as a safety precaution. Safety of our passengers is our top priority and **NO exceptions will be made.**

- Passenger count for trip will be determined by destination requirements. This may be anywhere from 20 to 40 passengers, at this time.
- Once we reach the bus limit, a waiting list will be used if cancellations occur.
- Passengers are required to show their **COVID-19** vaccination card as proof that they are fully vaccinated before boarding.
- Masks, social distancing and washing or sanitizing hands frequently are required.

- Proper wearing of masks is required. They should be worn from over your nose down underneath your chin. They must be worn properly from the time you line-up to get on the bus until you have exited the bus.
- Temperature will be taken at the time of boarding the bus. No one will travel with an illness such as flu, COVID-19, fever symptoms or generally not feeling well.
- New Waiver form and regulations will be attached to the sign-up sheet to be completed and returned with **your** payment and sign-up sheet.

The committee understands these restrictions are over and above what has been done in the past, but when COVID-19 regulations change, so will we. Trips will be announced on the Just In Fun Page on the www.stjustin.net website along with the appropriate sign-up forms and in the church lobby.
